ADMISSION

HOUSING

ATTENDANCE POLICY

Students are expected to attend all classes and, when absent, are responsible for work missed. However, the individual faculty member establishes the attendance policy for the course and informs students of this policy at the beginning of the session.

GRADING SYSTEM

Midland utilizes the dual grading system of letter grades (A, B, C, D, F) and pass/pass marginal/no credit (P/PM/NC). The A-F system is used in the majority of courses, although the student may choose to be graded by the alternate P/NC system. The instructor decides the time during the course when the grade choice must be made by the student. Exclusive of courses graded P/NC only, students are limited to one P/NC option per term. Thus, only one summer course may be by the P/NC option.
